

The TACHS exam will be administered as an online, at-home, remote test this year, therefore it is extremely important that you prepare your testing device several days before the day of testing. Do not wait until the day of testing, or it may negatively affect your testing experience.

DATA SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

- Windows *10 or 11
*While Proctorio and the exam continue to support Windows 10 for 2025, we strongly recommend updating to Windows 11 if at all possible.
- Mac OS 11 or higher
- Current version of Chrome with Proctorio Secure Exam Proctor Chrome extension
- 250 MB of free disk space
- 4 GB Ram or more for optimal performance.
- High speed internet
- Microphone, internal or external
- Webcam

After 1:00 PM on November 5, 2025, you will receive an email from tachs@tachs.riverside-insights.com with your test session information. If you do not receive your email, check your spam or junk folder. You will be required to enter the student's TACHS id and the email address you provided at the time of registration.
