Registration will open on August 26, 2024, at 9:00 AM EST, and will close on October 30, 2024. at 10:59 PM EST. **Do not miss the deadline; there are no exceptions.**

Methods of Registration

Method 1 - Internet PREFERRED

Students, parents, guardians, or principals may register students via the Internet using the registration link.

Method 2 - Telephone

Students or their parents/guardians may register by telephone, using 1-866-61TACHS (1-866-618-2247). Telephone registration is available Monday-Friday from 8:00 AM-7:00 PM EST and Saturday-Sunday from 10:00 AM-2:00 PM EST. If English is not the native language of the caller, an operator speaking that person's language will be made available.

Please have your credit card or debit card available. Registration fee is \$71. The fee will typically be listed as "TACHS" or as a fee from Illinois on your credit card statement. Please call us to verify the fee before disputing it with your bank.

Review Proctorio Consent Form

Understand the use of Proctorio; the AI (Artificial Intelligence) system that will monitor and record your student's test session and be able to consent to the contents of the Proctorio Consent Form before beginning the registration process. There is no requirement to sign or return this form to the TACHS Examination Office or Diocese. To consent to the agreement, you will check the box on the online registration form prior to entering student information or give the Call Center representative the verbal agreement to check the box for you.

The <u>only</u> accommodation allowed will be extended testing time of time and a half. The IEP, 504 Request and Plan, or evaluation form must be submitted along with the Eligibility Form to qualify. Forms will not be accepted after October 4, 2024. Any undelivered email or delayed forms are not the responsibility of the TACHS Examination Office or the Diocese. Approval of your extended time accommodation will be sent to you via email. If you do not receive verification of approval for extended time accommodations by October 13, 2023, contact your aligned Diocese immediately. <u>Absolutely no exceptions to, or extensions of, the deadline will be accepted/allowed.</u>

SCHEDULING CONFLICTS

Students taking the REGIS exam should register for the TACHS exam. On the day of TACHS testing, you will be considered a no-show, and will be scheduled for the make-up exam. To be eligible for the make-up you MUST be registered by October 30, 2024. A new test session code will be available to you on November 13, 202. You may not use the original test session code that was assigned to you for November 9, 2024.

If you have any other personal, family, or school conflicts on the days of testing, please make arrangements needed to be available for the exam.

HIGH SCHOOL CHOICES

After you register, but prior to November 9, 2024, at 11:59 EST, enter your high school choices <u>link to entering your HS choices</u>. You will need your TACHS id and the email address you used at the time of registration to access the form. Your choices may be entered/changed until November 9, 2024, at 11:59 PM EST. Failure to complete this information by the deadline, will result in scores being unavailable to your high school choices. Each student may enter up to 3 choices. If you wish to apply to additional schools, you may access a copy of your Home Report online on January 24, 2025. after 5:00 PM EST, and provide a copy of your report to those additional schools.

Requesting a refund and Refund Policy

You will need to have the following information available

- TACHS id(s) that you want to cancel, was erroneously assigned, or there was a duplicate charge
 on your credit card. Please note that a fee may show on your statement as pending and may fall
 off the next day.
- student first and last name
- name and contact information of person requesting the refund
- credit card type
- last 4 digits of the credit card you used at the time of registration
- reason for refund request.

If eligible, refunds will be issued within 3 days and should appear on your bank statement 3-7 days after the refund has been processed. Please do not dispute the fee through your bank, call us at 1-866-61TACHS (1-866-618-2247) first to check the status of your refund or to discuss a duplicate charge.

To be eligible for a full refund amount of \$71 USD, refund requests must be submitted prior to **October 30, 2024, 5:00 PM EST.** After that timeframe, Riverside has incurred processing and documentation expenses, and will not accept refund requests.

To be eligible for a refund after October 30, 2024, 5:00 PM EST, the following circumstances MUST be proven:

- A student was unable to attend his/her original test date and all subsequent make-up offerings due to unforeseen illness/extenuating family circumstances. Refunds will be reviewed and/or approved on a case-by-case basis; refunds are not guaranteed. Refunds will not be issued/offered at any time due to the following:
